Rules for Paint the Past: Plein Air Festival

1. Each artist's work will be evaluated by a jury and registrants will be notified of results by May 15.
2. This event will take place regardless of the weather.
3. Check-in will take place on Friday during the 9 a.m. meet and greet in MacBeath Hall at Kings Landing's Welcome Centre
4. All canvases, panels, and/or paper must be stamped PRIOR to painting. No unstamped art will be accepted for the exhibition and art sale. No pre-painted, stained or marked supports will be stamped.
5. Supports and framed artwork ready for display may not exceed 18" x 24". Artists must provide their own materials.
6. Artists may paint any outdoor subject and/or scene within Kings Landing.
7. Each work of art must be started and completed en plein air at Kings Landing.
8. Paint the Past's reception and awards ceremony will take place on Sunday at MacBeath Hall at 4 p.m.
9. Artworks will be made available for purchase at Kings Landing and online for the duration of the exhibition and a 40% commission will be retained by Kings Landing for any work sold.
10. The artist must be registered for the event to participate in the exhibition and sale.
11. Artworks for the exhibition must be turned in at MacBeath Hall at 2 p.m. on Sunday.
12. Artists will select a maximum of three (3) of their artworks for exhibition and sale.
13. All artwork for the show must have the artist clearly identified on the back as well as be stamped. An identification card provided by Kings Landing must be attached to the work of art stating the artist's name, the title of the work and the price.
14. Works of art must be submitted in a manner that allows for handling and display on an easel or wall.
15. Event staff will set up the artwork for the jury process and exhibition. Artists are not permitted in MacBeath Hall between the time they submit their artwork(s), 2 p.m. and the time of the reception and awards ceremony, 4 p.m.
16. Artists should be prepared to leave their artwork at MacBeath Hall until the end of the exhibition on July 31.
17. Artwork may be picked up at Kings Landing from July 31 until August 7 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. If you are unable to retrieve your work, alternative arrangements must be made in advance.

Artists' Acknowledgement

1. As an entrant of the Paint the Past: Plein Air Festival, I understand that Kings Landing reserves the right to not accept artworks that do not fall within the rules of the competition.
2. I declare that the work(s) of art submitted for Paint the Past are my own work and I am not aware of any ownership of copyright of another person to the image.
3. I acknowledge receipt of the rules governing the event and agree, as a condition of entering Paint the Past, that Kings Landing may publicize and/or broadcast my name, likeness, photographs of my work and the fact that I participated in the event. This includes all rights to reproduce, re-publish and re-print, in whole or in part, the photographs in any format or media, and irrevocably waives any and all of the artist's rights to the photographs in favour of Kings Landing.
