

Charles Morehouse

(August 28, 1799-December 20, 1897)¹

Charles was christened in the Woodstock Anglican Church in 1799. He was the son of Daniel Morehouse and Jane Gill Morehouse, the youngest of six sons and one daughter. He married, in 1849, Frances Jemima Earle (1823-1902) an Irish immigrant. They had three daughters, Frances, Cecilia, and Margaret. They had three sons, Richard, Thomas and Charles.

Charles was a farmer, miller (sawmill and gristmill) and a Lieutenant in the militia. He lived on the homestead until he married and then moved to a house on the same farm. That home later burned and he moved to Dumphries.²
