Currently, Weber is the Site Manager for the Klondike National Historic Sites within Parks Canada where he is responsible for five national historic sites in the Yukon. He has overseen the implementation of \$25M worth of capital infrastructure projects including federal heritage buildings, created an external advisory committee, developed visitor experience and interpretation programs, and lead the implementation of real property and collections rationalization to achieve a sustainable operation.

Throughout his career, he has partnered with municipal, provincial and federal government partners, private sector, community partners and organizations, as well as Indigenous communities, union executives, and a wide range of advisory boards. Before joining Parks Canada, Weber worked with the Métis Nation Alberta in interpretive programming and campground management.
