What is Kings Landing?

There’s no time like the present to discover the past! Kings Landing takes aim at how history is told and pushes the boundaries of open-air museums. Situated along the Wolastoq (Saint John River), this 300-acre museum is home to over 90,000 artefacts and a 19th-century village full of costumed characters, farm animals and 70 historic buildings. Kings Landing also offers workshops, educational programs, children’s summer camps, exhibits, and unique culinary experiences.
