

Kings Landing Spring Activity Programs 2024



All of Kings Landing's Education Programs are designed to provide high quality learning activities which emphasize knowledge and understanding through student involvement. Our program emphasis is to offer a specific program to each grade level.

School programs will be available June 5 to June 26, 2024.

Although the subject and tasks vary with the grade levels, all groups go through these three stages during their visit.

- 1) Introduction by Kings Landing staff
- 2) Activities assigned and supervised by Kings Landing staff
- 3) Evaluation and reflection of the visit

- \$255 for a group of 40 or less. (tax included)
 - Free admission for the required number of adults (1 adult for 10 children is necessary)
 - Additional teachers, supervisor, or students: \$10 each will be added to your bill (tax included)



Kindergarten – Grade 2: A Farm of Long Ago

Students will explore a farm of long ago to discover the types of animals and their usage. You will experience a variety of activities common to a child's life on the farm. You will be presented with selections of entertainment, chores and clothing, all major parts of 19th century life. You are welcome to stay as long as you wish following your tour.

Grades 3 and 4: Community Members and Lifestyle

Students will explore and discover the community members and their lifestyle. You will identify our Loyalist families, their trades and why they settled along the St. John River Valley. You will discuss responsibilities of young people and experience a typical chore of the 19th century. You are welcome to stay as long as you wish following your tour.

- Program Length: 1.5 hours
- Available: June 5-26, 2024



Grades 5 and 6: Early Settlement and Resources

Students will explore the geographical features of Kings Landing and their resources available in early communities. You will examine methods of communication and settlement patterns through a newspaper and maps. You are welcome to stay as long as you wish following your tour.

Grades 7-12: A Community of the Past

Students will explore and discover the community and their lifestyles including various economical standings and professions. You will identify why these families settled in the area and what they do to make their living. You are welcome to stay as long as you wish following your tour.

Grades 9-12: Traditional Sustainability and Self Reliance

Students will explore some of the methods used in the 19th century to survive, and even thrive, without modern convenience. You will learn how various animals and crops were integral to survival and learn about living in harmony with nature. You are welcome to stay as long as you wish following your tour.

- Available: June 5-26, 2024



Spring forward as we lead you back in time with a 90-minute guided tour

Discover family membership, chores and responsibilities, trades and occupations of a 19th century St. John River Valley community. Your guide will focus on the age level of your group to help them imagine what life would have been like for them. You are welcome to stay as long as you wish following your tour.

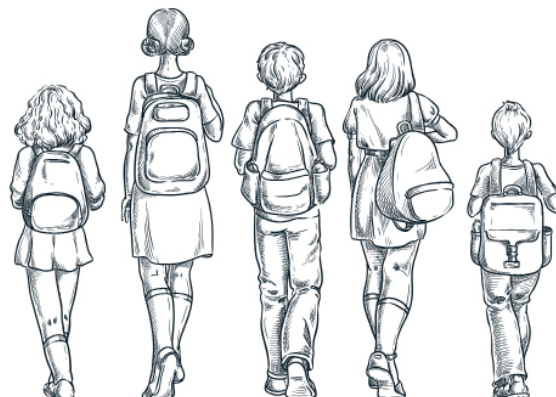

- You will receive written confirmation detailing your program via e-mail. Please return the questionnaire to enable us to be prepared for your group as soon as possible.

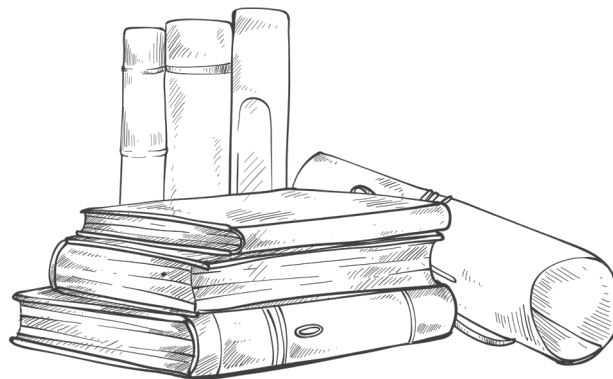
